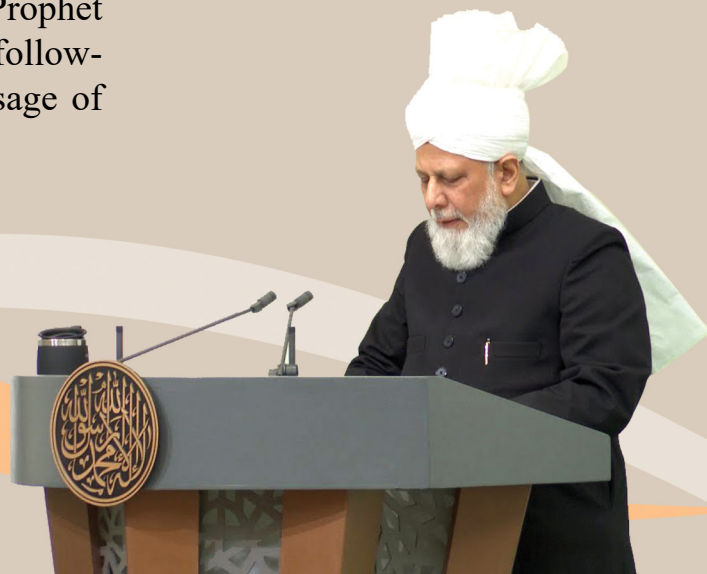


Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad said:

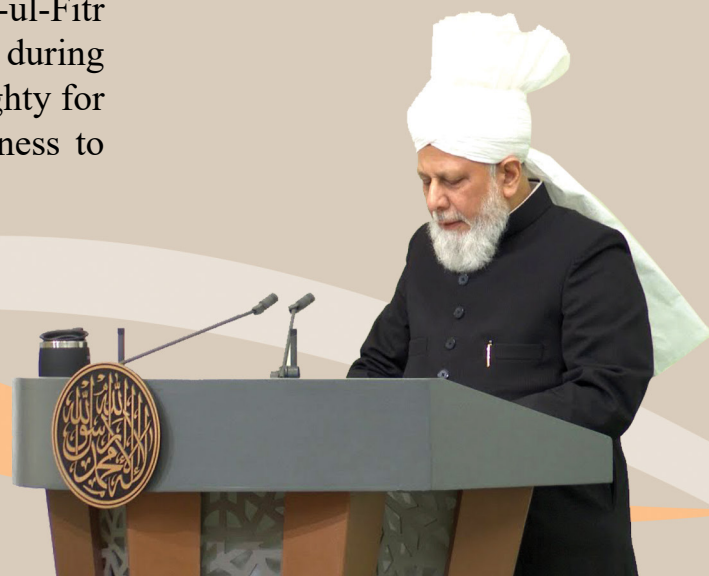


Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad said:

On 27 March 2026, the Worldwide Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, His Holiness Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, delivered the Friday Sermon at Mubarak Mosque in Islamabad, Tilford, UK.

During the sermon, His Holiness continued speaking on the life of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), highlighting his constant struggle to establish Tauhid – the Oneness of Allah the Almighty. Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad also continued to urge the Community to pray in light of the current global situation, particularly the worsening effects of war in the Middle East

“The conditions of war are continuing to worsen. The United States and Israel appear intent on establishing their dominance across the world, and particularly within the Muslim world. When the war in Palestine first began, the Israeli Prime Minister stated that the map of the region would be changed. These efforts are now aimed at reshaping that very map. The Muslim world should also recognise the direction in which these powers are moving, and understand that unity among Muslims is of utmost necessity.”



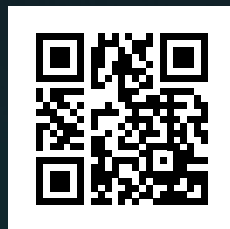
